- Did the writer stick to the topic and make it very clear to the reader?
- Is the topic clear because the writer included many interesting and important details or examples?
- Does the writing begin with lead sentences that grab your attention, a middle with many, supporting, juicy details, and an ending that wraps everything up nicely?
- Is the writing interesting with words that paint a picture in the reader's mind and sentences that begin in interesting and different ways?
- As a listener, what do I like or think is good about this piece?
- Do I have any questions and/or suggestions for the writer?
